 - i. "I was wondering about whether there are any new developments in Westminster regarding renewable energy like solar or wind power." The City currently has solar PV arrays on the roofs of the Public Safety Center, Westview Rec Center, Municipal Services Center, and City Park Rec Center. The City is analyzing expanding our sited solar arrays at parking lots, Irving Street Library, The MAC, and other Recreation facilities. The new

courthouse will be LEED Silver and likely have roof mounted and parking lot arrays of solar PV arrays.

- ii. "What sustainable developments/new technologies have they been looking into?" All new City buildings are required to be LEED Silver Certified which ensures buildings have a high energy efficiency performance and hit other sustainability indicator for new development. This requirement is also applied to the new Downtown Westminster development. The City is working with regional partners to promote the electrification of buildings— this means the cooking, heating and cooling, and other energy using systems of the building do not use fossil fuels like natural gas but instead use electricity which will get "greener" over time as Xcel Energy (our local utility) uses more renewable energy in it's sourcing. As of now 44% of Xcel Energy's electricity comes from renewable sources like solar and wind. In transitioning our buildings to electric appliances we can make sure that in the future all our energy use is powered from renewable sources.
