TENATIVE Results

3.C. SHALL CITY OF WESTMINSTER TAXES BE INCREASED BY \$19 MILLION ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR AND BY SUCH AMOUNTS AS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY INCREASING THE EXISTING CITY SALES AND USE TAX BY 0.5%, WITH ONE-HALF OF SUCH ADDITIONAL TAX AUTHORIZATION TO EXPIRE ON JANUARY 1, 2045, AND THE RESULTING TAX REVENUES BEING USED TO:

- RECRUIT AND RETAIN FIREFIGHTER PERSONNEL AND PERSONNEL TO PROVIDE DIRECT SUPPORT TO FIREFIGHTERS,
- CONSTRUCT STRATEGICALLY PLACED FIRE STATIONS AND FACILITIES AND UPDATE EXISTING FIRE STATIONS TO MEET SAFETY AND BUILDING STANDARDS,
- PROVIDE UP-TO-DATE FIREFIGHTER SAFETY GEAR AND EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT TO BETTER PROTECT THE PUBLIC AND FIRST RESPONDERS AND WITH THE RESULTING TAX REVENUE BEING ALLOWED TO BE COLLECTED AND SPENT NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LIMITATIONS PROVIDED BY LAW?
