A BILL

FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGETS OF THE GENERAL; UTILITY; UTILITY CAPITAL PROJECT RESERVE; GOLF COURSE; FLEET; INVESTIGATION **RECOVERIES; PARKS, OPEN SPACE AND TRAILS AND GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION** FROM THE 2023 CARRYOVER AND 2024 REVISED REVENUES

THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The 2024 appropriation for the General; Utility; Utility Capital Project Reserve; Golf Course; Fleet; Investigation Recoveries; Parks, Open Space and Trails and General Capital Improvement Funds, initially appropriated by Ordinance No. 4221 is hereby increased in aggregate by \$243,512,515. This appropriation is due to 2023 carryover and 2024 revised revenue.

Section 2. The \$243,512,515 increase shall be allocated to City Revenue and Expense accounts as described in the City Council Agenda Item dated October 21, 2024, (a copy of which may be obtained from the City Clerk) amending City fund budgets as follows:

Section 3 – Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be considered as severable. If any section, paragraph, clause, word, or any other part of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such part shall be deemed as severed from this ordinance. The invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect the construction or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, unless it is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction that a contrary result is necessary in order for this Ordinance to have any meaning whatsoever.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage after the second reading.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published in full within ten days after its enactment.
