A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, COLORADO, WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY ENTERPRISE, WATER AND WASTEWATER REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2024 Purpose: Authorizing the issuance of tax-exempt Utility Enterprise Revenue Bonds for the construction of a new Drinking Water Facility, and related Bond Cost of Issuance expenses.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW SECTION 13-1-17 ESTABLISHING SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR THE WESTMINSTER HILLS OPEN SPACE Purpose: To add a new section to the code regarding the Westminster Hills Open Space area.
