Summary of Proceedings**

Summary of proceedings of the Westminster Special City Council meeting of Monday, October 21, 2024. Mayor McNally, Mayor Pro Tem Nurmela, and Councillors Carmelia, DeMott, Ezeadi (virtual), Hott (virtual), and Ireland were present at roll call.

City Council held a public hearing on: Adoption of the 2025 Budget

City Council adopted: Resolution No. 26 establishing the 2025 Pay Plans; and Resolution No. 27 Setting the 2024 Mill Levy Collectible in 2025, Adopting the Budget and Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2025

City Council passed on first reading:

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGETS OF THE GENERAL; UTILITY; UTILITY CAPITAL PROJECT RESERVE; GOLF COURSE; FLEET; INVESTIGATION RECOVERIES; PARKS, OPEN SPACE AND TRAILS AND GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE 2023 CARRYOVER AND 2024 REVISED REVENUES** Purpose: To address budget adjustments and re-allocations of unspent monies.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTERS 7, 8, AND 12 OF TITLE VIII OF THE WESTMINSTER MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING THE AMOUNT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF WATER, SEWER, RECLAIMED WATER FEES AND RATES** Purpose: Updating the code regarding water, sewer, reclaimed water fees and rates.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PAY THE EXPENSE OF CONTINUING THE PUBLIC BUSINESS FOR THE YEAR 2025 AND OTHER PURPOSES REQUIRED BY THE CHARTER AND BY ANY OTHER LAW** Purpose: To allocate funds necessary for the operation of government functions and public services in 2025.

There was no further business to come before the City Council, and the meeting adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
