## Paving in Sheridan Green North area to begin as soon as Wednesday, July 3rd

Crews are preparing to pave several roads in the Sheridan Green North neighborhood including: Otis St., Newland St., Marshall Ct., Marshall St., Lamar St., north of 115<sup>th</sup> Ave., 115<sup>th</sup> Ave., 115<sup>th</sup> Pl., Kendall Cir., Kendall St., 116<sup>th</sup> Ave., Jay St., 115<sup>th</sup> Pl., Ingalls St., and Harlan St., Work is expected to last from 7 a.m. - 7p.m. Please follow no parking signs.

Work anticipated to take place between July 3<sup>rd</sup>-July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Paving is weather dependent and subject to change. We apologize in advance for any potential inconvenience construction may cause. Below is the tentative schedule:

- As soon as Wednesday, July 3rd: Crews anticipate grinding existing asphalt in preparation for paving
  - Please remove trash receptacles and sporting equipment such as basketball hoops from the roadway
  - Be cautious of manhole and valve castings in the roadway, as they will be lifted higher after grinding is complete
  - If you need to street park, please utilize a street without "no parking signs"
- As soon as Tuesday, July 16<sup>th</sup>: Street sequence and direction of paving is to be determined
  - New pavement will take 3-4 hours to cure, and crews will re-open driveways as they are ready.
  - Anticipate driveway and parking access to be impacted for at least 1 day
- Vehicles left on the street during indicated work times will be towed to an adjacent street without "No Parking" signs



## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING PAVING

- You will NOT be able to go in or out of driveways when the road is closed and paving is in process
- If you need to leave your home during the hours of paving, it is recommended that you plan ahead and park your car on nearby streets without "no parking" signs.
- "No Parking" signs will be placed at least 48 hours ahead of work beginning
- Expect noise, tar-like odors, and large equipment
- Fresh pavement is hot, oily, and extremely sticky. Please keep off new pavement if you are walking, especially with dogs, as the oil and pavement can hurt and is difficult to remove from fur, feet, clothes, carpets, and cars
- Emergency access for residents will be maintained at all times during construction
